# **HOW GOD GIVES US HOPE**

## **H**E **KNOWS** ALL ABOUT ME.

"For I know the plans I have for you," says the LORD. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope." (Jeremiah 29:11, NLT)

"I am radiant with joy because of your mercy, for you have listened to my troubles and have seen the crisis in my soul." (Psalm 31:7, The Living Bible)

## OFFERS HIS **COMFORT** TO ME.

"When doubts filled my mind, your comfort gave me renewed hope and cheer." (Psalm 94:19, NLT)

"I have hope when I think of this: The LORD's love never ends; his mercies never stop. They are new every morning..." (Lamentations 3:21–23, NCV)

## PROMISES TO FORGIVE ME.

"...put your hope in the LORD, because with the LORD there is mercy and with him there is unlimited forgiveness." (Psalm 130:7, GW)

"God is faithful and reliable. If we confess our sins, he forgives them and cleanses us from everything we've done wrong." (1 John 1:9, GW)

## EXTENDS HIS **POWER** TO HELP ME.

"Blessed are those whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the LORD their God." (Psalm 146:5, NIV)
