Israel's Cycle



In those days Israel had no king; all the people did whatever seemed right in their own eyes. Judges 21:25 NLT

"Now fear the LORD and serve him with all faithfulness. <u>Throw away the gods</u> your ancestors worshiped beyond the Euphrates River and in Egypt, and serve the LORD. Joshua 24:14 NIV

Then the <u>people</u> answered, "Far be it from us to forsake the LORD to serve other gods! It was the LORD our God himself who brought us and our parents up out of <u>Egypt</u>, from that land of <u>slavery</u>, and performed those great signs before our eyes...We too will serve the LORD, because he is our God." Joshua 24:16-18 NIV

But the people said to Joshua, "No! We will serve the LORD." Joshua 24:21 NIV

Then the Israelites did evil in the <u>eyes</u> of the LORD and served the <u>Baals</u>. They <u>forsook</u> the LORD, the God of their ancestors, who had brought them out of Egypt. In his anger against Israel the LORD <u>gave them</u> into the hands of raiders who plundered them. He <u>sold</u> them into the hands of their enemies all around, whom they were <u>no longer able to resist</u>...They were in great <u>distress</u>. Judges 2:11-15 NIV

Israel's Choices

Forsook the Lord.

Followed the people around them.

Surrendered their freedom.

Israel simply traded one king for another and they were no longer able to resist.

It's always easier to say "no" to <u>God</u> than it is to say "no" to the things you <u>substitute</u> for God.

The anger of the LORD burned against Israel so that he sold them into the hands of Cushan-Rishathaim <u>king</u> of Aram Naharaim, to whom the Israelites were subject for eight years. Judges 3:8 NIV
