TOP MARRIAGE MYTHS

WHAT USUALLY GOES WRONG IN A MARRIAGE

- 1. UNRESOLVED pain.
- 2. **UNMET** expectations.
- 3. UNDERESTIMATED differences.
- 4. **<u>UNFORGIVEN</u>** mistakes.

HOW TO DO A MARRIAGE MAKEOVER

A<u>CCEPT</u> RESPONSIBILITY FOR <u>MY ACTIONS</u>.

"It's easy to see a smudge on your neighbor's face and be oblivious to the ugly sneer on your own. Do you have the nerve to say, 'Let me wash your face for you,' when your own face is distorted by contempt? ...Wipe that ugly sneer off your own face, and you might be fit to offer a washcloth to your neighbor." (Matthew 7:3–5, The Message)

"Each person must be responsible for himself." (Galatians 6:5, NCV)

B<u>ELIEVE</u> MY MARRIAGE <u>CAN CHANGE</u>.

"Jesus looked at them intently and said, "Humanly speaking, it is impossible. But with God everything is possible." (Matthew 19:26, NLT)

Two Poisonous Practices

1) **COMPLAINING**.

"Do everything without complaining and arguing," (Philippians 2:14, NLT)

2) COMPARING.

"That means we will not compare ourselves with each other as if one of us were better and another worse..." (Galatians 5:26, The Message)

CLOSE THE BACK DOOR OF **DIVORCE**.

"And let us not get tired of doing what is right...we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't get discouraged and give up." (Galatians 6:9, The Living Bible)

DEAL WITH UNRESOLVED HURTS.

• BY <u>ASKING</u> FORGIVENESS

"Admit your faults to one another and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results." (James 5:16, The Living Bible/NLT)

• BY OFFERING FORGIVENESS

"Be gentle and ready to forgive; never hold grudges. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others." (Colossians 3:13, The Living Bible)

E<u>NLIST</u> SUPPORT.

"Get all the advice you can and be wise the rest of your life." (Proverbs 19:20, The Living Bible)
