"The Lord is my shepherd; I have everything I need. He lets me <u>REST</u> in green pastures. He leads me to <u>CALM</u> water. He <u>REFRESHES</u> and <u>RESTORES</u> my life." (Psalm 23:1-3a, NCV/AMP)

WHAT NOT TO DO WHEN YOU'RE HURTING

1. DON'T RUN FROM IT.

"I said, "I wish I had wings like a dove. Then I would fly away and rest. I would wander far away and stay in the desert. I would hurry to my place of escape, far away from the wind and storm."" (Psalm 55:6–8, NCV)

2. DON'T REPRESS IT.

"So I kept very quiet. I didn't even say anything good, but I became even more upset. I became very angry inside, and as I thought about it, my anger burned." (Psalm 39:2–3, NCV)

"When I kept it all inside, my bones turned to powder, my words became daylong groans." (Psalm 32:3, MSG)

3. DON'T REHEARSE IT.

"To worry yourself to death with resentment would be a foolish, senseless thing to do." (Job 5:2, GNB)

"You are only hurting yourself with your anger." (Job 18:4a, GNB)

WHAT GOD SAYS TO DO WHEN YOU'RE HURTING

Psalm 23:5-6

1. LET JESUS SETTLE THE SCORE.

"You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies." (Psalm 23:5a, NIV)

"Never pay back evil for evil...never avenge yourselves. Leave that to God, for he has said that he will repay those who deserve it." (Romans 12:17-19a, The Living Bible)

"Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy." (Matthew 5:7, NIV)

2. LET JESUS HEAL MY WOUNDS.

"You anoint my head with oil." (Psalm 23:5b, NIV)

"He heals the brokenhearted and bandages their wounds." (Psalm 147:3, NCV)

3. LET JESUS **SATISFY** MY NEEDS.

"My cup overflows." (Psalm 23:5c, NIV)
