## **DEALING WITH MY DEBT**

### **DEBT 101**

• DEBT IS AN ASSUMPTION.

"Don't brag about tomorrow, since you don't know what the day will bring." (Proverbs 27:1, NLT)

• DEBT IS A SYMPTOM.

"The Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: ...self-control..." (Galatians 5:22–23, NLT)

• DEBT IS AN OBSTRUCTION.

"No one can serve two masters...You cannot serve both God and money." (Matthew 6:24, NLT)

# **HOW TO GET OUT OF DEBT**

1. COMMIT TO DEBT ELIMINATION.

"The wicked borrow and never repay..." (Psalm 37:21, NLT)

"Pay all your debts." (Romans 13:8a, The Living Bible)

## **AVOID DEBT CONSOLIDATION SCHEMES**

"Committed and persistent work pays off; get-rich-quick schemes are ripoffs."

(Proverbs 28:20, The Message)

2. **EXAMINE** HOW YOU GOT INTO DEBT.

"Let us examine and see what we have done and then return to the LORD." (Lamentations 3:40, NCV)

O WHAT'S MY REASON?

JESUS: "Beware! Guard against every kind of greed. Life is not measured by how much you own." (Luke 12:15, NLT)

## ○ WHAT'S THE HURRY?

"The plans of hard-working people earn a profit, but those who act too quickly become poor." (Proverbs 21:5, NCV)
