Grace is: UNDERSERVED UNMERITED UNEARNED

1. Grace starts with LOVE.

<u>For God so loved</u> the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16 NIV)

2. Grace is a <u>Gift</u>.

For it is by <u>grace</u> you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the <u>gift</u> of God— not by works, so that no one can boast. (Ephesians 2:8-9 NIV)

3. Grace acts **FIRST**.

But God <u>demonstrates</u> his own love for us in this: While we were <u>still</u> sinners, Christ died for us. (Romans 5:8 NIV)

4. Grace includes TRUTH.

For the wages of sin is death, <u>but</u> the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23 NIV)

5. Grace costs <u>SOMETHING</u>.

We know what real love is because <u>Jesus gave up his life</u> for us. So we also ought to <u>give</u> <u>up our lives</u> for our brothers and sisters. (1 John 3:16 NIV)
