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The Foundation

The Fall

"At that moment their eyes were opened, and they suddenly felt shame at their nakedness. So they sewed fig leaves together to cover themselves. When the cool evening breezes were blowing, the man and his wife heard the LORD God walking about in the garden. So they hid from the LORD God among the trees." (Genesis 3:7, NLT)

The Fallout: Identity Crisis

1. Our self-CONCEPT became confused.

...their eyes were opened...

2. Our self-ESTEEM became filled with contempt.

...felt shame at their nakedness...

3. We became self-CONSCIOUS and try to cover up our brokenness.

...they sewed fig leaves together to cover themselves...

4. We became self-<u>CENTERED</u> and turned on each other.

"It was the woman you put here with me," the man said. "She gave me some of the fruit, and I ate it."" (Genesis 3:12, CEV)

Case Study of Identity Recovery: Moses

Hebrews 11:23-27 (NIV)

²³ By faith Moses' parents hid him for three months after he was born, because they saw he was no ordinary child, and they were not afraid of the king's edict.

²⁴ By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. ²⁵ He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. ²⁶ He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of

greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.

27 By faith he left Egypt, not fearing the king's anger; he persevered because he saw
him who is invisible.

Knowing My Identity...

1. Demonstrates **MATURITY**.

"...when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter." (Hebrews 11:24, NIV)

2. Defines my <u>RESPONSIBILITIES</u>.

"He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin." (Hebrews 11:25, NIV)

3. Decides my PRIORITIES.

"He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward." (Hebrews 11:26, NIV)

The World's Priorities

(vs. 24) POPULARITY (vs. 25) PLEASURE (vs. 26) POSSESSIONS

Moses' Priorities

- 1) EMBRACING GOD'S **PURPOSE**.
 - 2) LOVING GOD'S **PEOPLE**.
 - 3) HAVING GOD'S PEACE.

4. Determines my **DESTINY**.

"...Moses left the land of Egypt, not fearing the king's anger. He kept right on going because he kept his eyes on the one who is invisible." (Hebrews 11:27, NLT)
