#### I WILL MISS MY MOMENT IF:

1. I HOLD ON TO MY FEAR.

"to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David." (Luke 1:27, NLT)

### 2. I HOLD ON TO MY EXPECTATIONS

"Mary asked the angel, "But how can I have a baby? I am a virgin."" (Luke 1:34, The Living Bible, Paraphrased)

### 3. I HOLD ON TO MY PRIDE

"Mary said, "I am the Lord's servant, and I am willing to do whatever he wants. . ." (Luke 1:38a, The Living Bible, Paraphrased)

### **HOW TO MAKE THE MOST OF MY MOMENT**

#### I MUST DECIDE TO:

### 1. GIVE MY CONCERNS TO GOD.

"Mary asked the angel, 'But how can this happen? I am a virgin." (Isaiah 40:27, NLT)

"Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6–7, NLT)

"For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline." (2 Timothy 1:7, NLT)

"But you are a chosen family, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who has called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;" (1 Peter 2:9, LSB)

### 2. SAY YES.
