WE WERE MADE FOR MINISTRY

- 1. WE MINISTER TO 3 DIMENSIONS.
 - People's PHYSICAL needs.

"For I was <u>hungry</u>, and you fed me. I was <u>thirsty</u>, and you gave me a drink. I was a <u>stranger</u>, and you invited me into your home. I was <u>naked</u>, and you gave me clothing. I was <u>sick</u>, and you cared for me. I was in <u>prison</u>, and you visited me...And the King will say, 'I tell you the truth, when you did it to one of the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were doing it to me!" (Matthew 25:35–36, NLT) (Matthew 25:40, NLT)

- People's **EMOTIONAL** needs.
 - "...Encourage those who are <u>timid</u>. [Render assistance] to those who are weak. Be patient with everyone." (1 Thessalonians 5:14, NLT)
- People's SPIRITUAL needs.

"Everything is from God, who has reconciled us to himself through Christ and has given us the ministry of reconciliation." (2 Corinthians 5:18, CSB)

- 2. WE MINISTER IN 3 DIRECTIONS.
 - To **UNBELIEVERS**.

"But I say, do not resist an evil person! If someone slaps you on the right cheek, offer the other cheek also. If you are sued in court and your shirt is taken from you, give your coat, too. If a soldier demands that you carry his gear for a mile, carry it two miles... You have heard the law that says, 'Love your neighbor' and hate your enemy. But I say, love

your enemies! Pray for those who persecute you! In that way, you will be acting as true children of your Father in heaven..." (Matthew 5:39–45, NLT)

You cannot win your enemies to Christ; you can only win your friends.

Give people what they need, not what they deserve.

To the <u>LORD</u>.

"While they were <u>serving</u> the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said to them, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul, to do the work to which I have called them."" (Acts 13:2, GNB)

Ministering unto the Lord means to serve as a volunteer in the church.

• To **BELIEVERS**.

"For God is not [unjust] to forget or overlook your labor and the love which you have shown for His name's sake in <u>ministering to the needs of the saints</u>, as you still do." (Hebrews 6:10, AMP)

God rewards our faithful service.

- 3. WE MINISTER IN 3 DESIGNATIONS.
 - **SPONTANEOUS** situations.

"If you know someone who doesn't have any clothes or food, you shouldn't just say, "I hope all goes well for you. I hope you will be warm and have plenty to eat." What good is it to say this, unless you do something to help?" (James 2:15–16, CEV)

See a need and fill it; find a hurt and heal it

SHORT-TERM projects.

"God blesses those who work for <u>peace</u>, for they will be called the children of God." (Matthew 5:9, NLT)

SHAPE-BASED roles.

"There are different kinds of spiritual <u>gifts</u>, but the same Spirit gives them. There are different <u>ways</u> of serving, but the same Lord is served. There are different <u>abilities</u> to
