# **Guarding Your Kids**

## What I Need to Protect My Kids From

### 1. Harmful <u>PEERS</u>.

"*Bad company* corrupts good character." (1 Corinthians 15:33b, NLT)

"The LORD lives! Praise to my Rock! May God, the Rock of my salvation, be exalted! ...He rescued me from [my enemies]. You pulled me from the grip of upstarts, <u>You saved me</u> <u>from the bullies</u>." (2 Samuel 22:47, 49, NLT / The Message)

#### 2. Heavy FEARS.

"The LORD is my light and my salvation— so why should I be afraid? <u>The LORD is my</u> <u>fortress, protecting me from danger</u>, so why should I tremble?" (Psalm 27:1, NLT)

#### Family Insecurity

"But, dear brothers, I beg you in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ to <u>stop arguing</u> among yourselves. Let there be real harmony so that there won't be <u>splits</u> in the church. <u>I plead</u> <u>with you</u> to be of one mind, united in thought and purpose." (1 Corinthians 1:10, The Living Bible, Paraphrased)

#### Material Insecurity

*"People who don't <u>take care of their relatives</u>, and especially <u>their own families</u>, have given up their faith. They are worse than someone who doesn't have faith in the Lord." (1 <i>Timothy 5:8, CEV*)

#### **Relational Insecurity**

"Now it is time to **forgive him and comfort him**. Otherwise he may become so bitter and discouraged that he won't be able to recover. Please show him now that you still do love him very much." (2 Corinthians 2:7–8, The Living Bible)

Stress

"<u>When anxiety overtakes me</u> and worries are many, Your comfort lightens my soul." (Psalm 94:19, VOICE) Contagious worry & peace

"**Don't worry about anything**; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience **God's peace**, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6–7, NLT)

## 3. **KNOWLEDGE** beyond their years.

"Be infants in evil, but in your thinking be mature." (1 Corinthians 14:20b, ESV)

"LORD, ...I am not concerned with great matters or with <u>subjects too difficult for me</u>. Instead, I am content and at peace. As a child lies quietly in its mother's arms, so my heart is quiet within me." (Psalm 131:1–2, GNB)
