## 1. You no longer value the uniqueness of the gospel

"We resist it through and through. Accepting this state of affairs strikes at our most deeply entrenched intuitions about the way the world works. We resist it not merely because it strikes at our pride, though it is true. More deeply, it seems to throw off our moral compass about who we are and how we can feel stable about our place in the universe. The Bible's teaching on justification by faith feels like moral vertigo, as if up is down and down is up. For we are being told to stop doing what is our inveterate inclination - to look inside to answer the questions Am I okay? Do I matter? What is the verdict over my life? Am I at peace with my Maker?" (Ortlund, Deeper, p. 87)
