

Exodus 12:3-19 Requirements for the Passover

- #1 – vv.3b-4** – Each household was to select a lamb on the 10th day of the 1st month.
- #2 – v.5a** – The lamb is to be **WITHOUT BLEMISH** (a picture of being sinless – Hebrews 4:15 & 2 Corinthians 5:21).
- #3 – v.5b** – The lamb is to be **MALE** of the first year (Jesus is the SON of God).
- #4 – v.6a** – The lamb was to be held until the 14th day (4 days of inspection or review - John 8:46, Mark 14:12-14).
- #5 – v.6b** – The lamb was to be killed “by the whole assembly of the congregation” of Israel at twilight (no one was exempt – Romans 6:23).
- #6 – vv.7 & 22** – The lamb’s blood was to be collected and painted onto the doorposts and lintel (Hebrews 10:26-29).
- #7 – v.8** – The lamb was to be eaten (we must partake of Him – John 6:48-56, 63).

Exodus 12:3-19 Requirements for the Passover

#8 – vv.8-9 – The lamb was to be roasted in fire (all offerings involved fire).

#9 – vv.8b & 11 – The lamb was to be eaten with unleavened bread (picture of Jesus the sinless bread of life – 1 Corinthians 5:6-7).

#10 – v.8b – The lamb was to be eaten with bitter herbs (Exodus 1:13-14).

#11 – v.10 – None of the lamb was to be left to the next day (no waster or decay was allowed – Psalm 16:10).

#12 – vv.11-13 – The lamb was to be eaten in haste (Hebrews 4:7-11).

And the Lord would PASSOVER every home with blood on the lintel and doorposts (Hebrews 9:22 & Matthew 26:27-28).

#13 – vv.14 & 17 – This day was to be a memorial & to be kept forever (we are never to forget THE Passover Lamb).

#14 – vv.15 & 18 & 20 – No unleavened bread for 7 days.

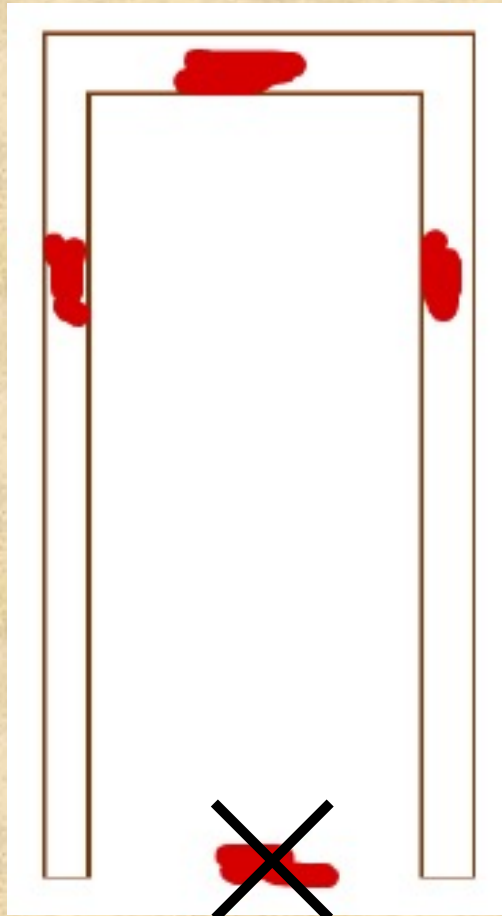
#15 – vv.15 & 19 – Anyone eating leavened bread was to be cut off.

#16 – v.16 – No work was to be one on days 1& 7 (some think all week).

The painted blood on the lintel and doorposts

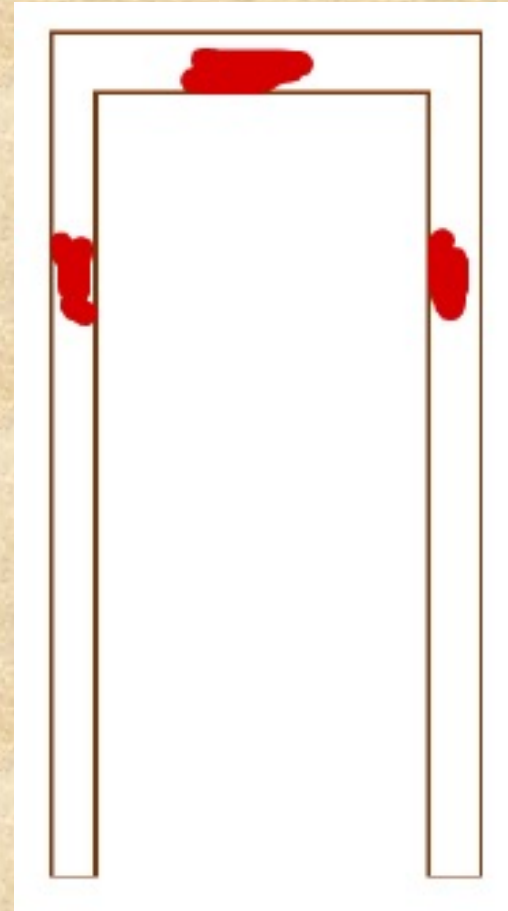

Group 1 - Springtime

1 Passover (Major)	...died for us.	3/27/21	4/15/22	14th Day of 1st Mo.	
2 Unleavened Bread	...is without sin.	3/28/21	4/16/22	15th Day of 1st Mo.	
3 Firstfruits	...rose from the dead.	3/29/21	4/17/22	16th Day of 1st Mo.	Barley Harvest

Group 2 - Early Summer

4 Weeks (Major)	...sent His Holy Spirit.	5/16/21	6/4/22	50 days after Passover	Shavuot or Pentecost or Firstfruits of Wheat Harvest
------------------------	--------------------------	---------	--------	------------------------	--

Group 3 - Fall

5 Trumpets	...will call us to Himself.	9/6/21	9/25/22	1st Day of 7th Mo.	Rosh Hashanah (Head of the year)
6 Day of Atonement	...provided us with access.	9/15/21	10/4/22	10th Day of 7th Mo.	Yom Kippur
7 Tabernacles (Major)	...wants to be with us.	9/20/21	10/9/22	15th Day of 7th Mo.	Sukkot or Ingathering or Booths

Red colored feasts - The 3 feasts all men had to come to Jerusalem for each year (Deuteronomy 16:16).
