This section is packed with God's judgment on nations.

Most sections begin with the words, "The burden against ..."

We see that in 13:1, 15:1, 17:1, 19:1, 21:1, 21:11, 21:13, 22:1, & 23:1.

Note: 14:24 & 17:12 doesn't have this & 14:28 has a slight word variance.

# Isaiah - Noteworthy Comments

#### #1 – The name of the book is beautiful.

The name "Isaiah" means "Yahweh is salvation".

This is so appropriate since he gave such beautiful pictures of Jesus. He also gave a very graphic picture of Jesus' suffering.

### #2 – Likely the most well-known prophetic book.

Not only was it reference a few times in the New Testament...

Referenced 21 times in the New Testament...the most of any prophetic book.

Jesus actually read directly from this book. Luke 4:17.

#### #3 – It contains some very well-known verses.

- Isaiah 1:18, ""Come now, and let us reason together," Says the LORD, "Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool."
- Isaiah 7:14, ""Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel."
- **Isaiah 9:6**, "For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace."
- **Isaiah 40:3**, "The voice of one crying in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the LORD; Make straight in the desert A highway for our God."
- Isaiah 40:31, "1 But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint."
- Isaiah 53...all of it.
