The Law of Moses (The Old Covenant) = Commandments + Penalty + Remedy

Purpose #1: To point out our sins through the Commandments

(Romans 3:20, 7:7, Galatians 3:19)

Purpose #2: To point out what we deserve due to sin...the penalty of death

(Romans 7:13, 4:14-15, Galatians 3:10)

Purpose #3: To point out God's solution for our sin ... a blood sacrifice

(Galatians 3:22-25, Romans 7:4)

The Commandments of the Law of Moses

1. Type 1: Moral

- <u>Examples</u>: Murder, Stealing, Lying, Adultery, etc.
 - These <u>ARE</u> repeated in the New Covenant because they represent a holy God and His nature.

2. Type 2: Ceremonial

- <u>Examples</u>: Sabbath, Dietary Laws, Circumcision, Bodily Discharges, etc.
 - These <u>ARE NOT</u> repeated in the New Covenant because they spoke of our need for Jesus.
 - So, once we come to Jesus they have been fulfilled.
 - In fact, some were specifically pointed out as NOT applying to us anymore in the New Covenant (Romans 14, Colossians 2:16-23, Galatians 5:6).

The Law of the Spirit (The New Covenant) = Commandments + Discipline + Power

Commandments (All over the New Testament)
Moral Commandments

+

Discipline (1 Corinthians 5, Hebrews 12:7-11)
Our Father disciplines us

+

Power (Acts 1:8, 2 Corinthians 12:9, 2 Timothy 1:7)
Indwelling Holy Spirit

So, we are not a lawless people!!!
