

Why did the Lord give us spiritual gifts?

(Aka: What does the Lord want us to do with them?)

#1 – We are to use them FOR THE PROFIT OF ALL!

1 Corinthians 12:7 says, “But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all.”

#2 – We are to use them to BUILD UP (edify) the Body of Christ!

1 Corinthians 14:12 says, “Even so you, since you are zealous for spiritual gifts, let it be for the edification of the church that you seek to excel.”

Ephesians 4:12 says the gifts are, “for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ,”

#3 – So, are we using our gifts since the Lord gave them to us for the profit of all to equip and to edify people around us?

Romans 12:6a says, “6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them...”

1 Peter 4:10 says, “As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.”

Question: Are we using our gifts to minister to each other or are we simply not using our gifts and hoarding them?

* - Note that the word for tongues is the greek word "glossa" and is used throughout 1 Corinthians 12 & 14 and is used in Acts 2:3,4,11,26.

But, the word for tongues in Acts 2:8 is the greek word "dialektos", meaning discourse or dialect. This word applied to the people hearing.
