Notes regarding "Migra": Migra = Hebrew words "qodesh migra" or "'Holy Convocation" (Lev. 23:2,3,4,7,8,21,24,27,35,36,37).

Migra type #1: The 52 weekly Sabbaths each year are all "migras".

Migra type #2: The 7 annual Sabbaths were also "migras".

Also these annual migras are known as a "High Day" or "High Sabbath".

Preparation Day: Any day of the year before a miqra (whether a weekly or annual miqra).
