**Lesson #2** – Never fall into the trap of defending yourself to people making assumptions about you.

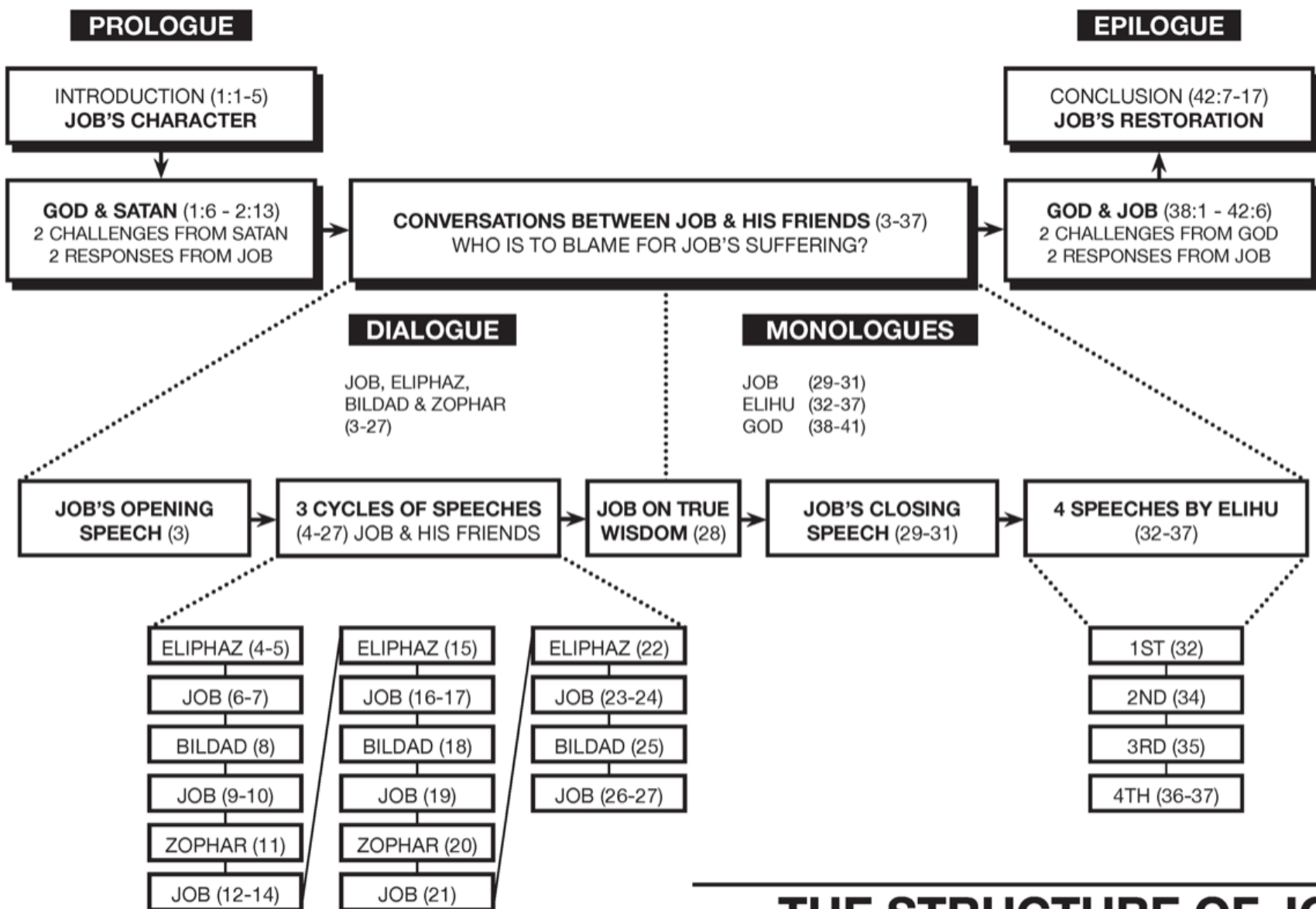
#2.1 – Job's friends made multiple wrong assumption about Job and attacked him as a result.

#2.3 – Job seemed to slowly fall into the trap of thinking he was going to question the Lord for what He let happen.

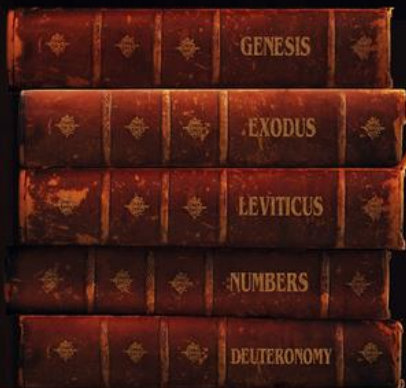
**Lesson #3** – Always trust the Lord when we're going through trials.

**Lesson #4** – Never forget God is infinitely wiser than us as well as more gracious than us.

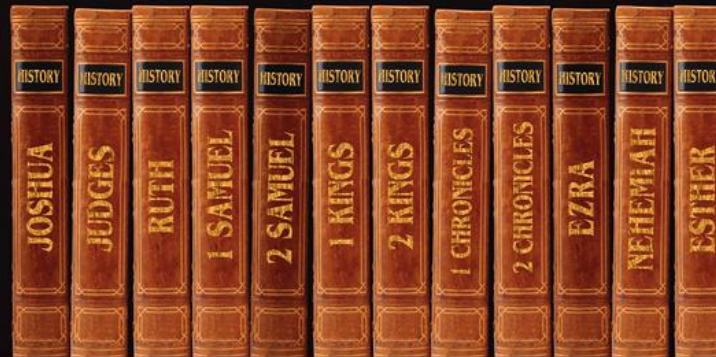

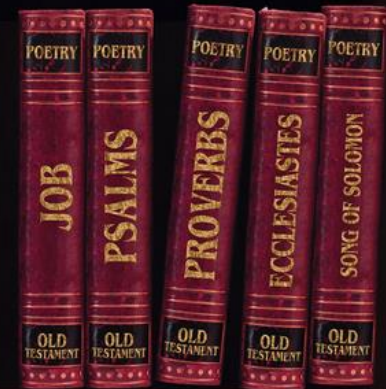
