- #4 v.3b Jesus is the express image of the person of the Father.
- #5 v.3c Jesus is upholding all things by the word of His power.
- #6 v.3d Jesus purged our sins.
- #7 v.3e Jesus sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.
- #8 v.4a Jesus has become so much better than the angels.
- #9 v.4b Jesus has obtained a more excellent name than the angels.

Why Jesus is so Much Greater than Angels (Hebrews 1:5-14)

- #1 v.5 The Father NEVER spoke to the angels like He did to Jesus.
 A quote of Psalm 2:7...a psalm about the Messiah.
- #2 v.6 The Father actually commanded all angels to worship Jesus. A quote of 2 Samuel 7:14.
- #3 v.7 The angels were created beings...Jesus was NOT.

 A reference from Psalm 97:7b & a quote of Psalm 104:4.
- #4 vv.8-9 The Father called Jesus "God". A quote of Psalm 45:6-7.
- #5 vv.10-12 The Father called Jesus "JEHOVAH" or "YAHWEH" and creator of the universe.

A quote from Psalm 102:25-27.

#6 – vv.13-14 – The Father also never said these things to angels...
A quote from Psalm 110:1 (v.13) and see Psalm 91:11 (for v.14).
