1. Things you have seen (Revelation 1).

• Jesus is revealed, encourages us and instructs John to record what he's seen.

2. Things which are (Revelation 2-3).

- The church age from Jesus' ascension to the rapture.
- Seven churches represent the church age.

3. Things that will take place after this (Revelation 4-22).

- **Revelation 4:1** The rapture of the church.
- **Revelation** 4-5 The scene in heaven.
- Revelation 6-18 The Great Tribulation.
 - The anti-Christ is introduced and signs a 7-year peace treaty.
 - o The 21 judgments are poured out.
 - Halfway into the tribulation, the anti-Christ will declare himself to be god.
 - The Jews will turn back to God.
- Revelation 19 Jesus returns to the earth to establish His kingdom.
- Revelation 20 Jesus' 1,000-year reign and judgment of the world.
- Revelation 21 Jesus presents a new heaven and new earth.
- Revelation 22 Final notes.

Revelation Judgments (21 of them - Seals & Trumpets & Bowls)

1. 7 Seal Judgments (Revelation 6:1-8:6).

• Seals #1-6 – Revelation 6.

Short parenthesis – Revelation 7 – The 144,000 & the tribulation martyrs.

• **Seal** #7 – Revelation 8:1-6.

2. 7 Trumpet Judgments (Revelation 8:7-14:20).

<u>Trumpets #1-6</u> – Revelation 8:7-9:21

• Long parenthesis - Revelation 10-14 - The 2 witnesses, Israel, Satan & the Anti-Christ and other things.

<u>Trumpet #7</u> – Revelation 11:15-19 (presented in the middle of the long parenthesis).

3. 7 Bowl Judgments (Revelation 15:1-16:21).

• Bowls #1-6 - Revelation 8:7-9:21

• Long parenthesis - Revelation 10-14 - The 2 witnesses, Israel, Satan & the Anti-Christ and other things.

Bowl #7 – Revelation 11:15-19 (given in the midst of the long parenthesis).

Note: Compare the 7th seal, 7th trumpet, & 7th Bowl Judgment.

Seal #7: - 8:5b - And there were noises, thunderings, lightnings, and an earthquake.

Trumpet #7:- 11:19 - And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.

Bowl #7:- 16:18 - And there were noises and thunderings and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on the earth.
