## The Consequences of Rejecting God's Truth

(Romans 1:18-2:10)

#### Round #1

<u>Rejection – 1:18b-20a</u> – They suppress the truth in unrighteousness.

**Consequences** – 1:20b – They are without excuse regarding God's existence.

#### Round #2

<u>Rejection -1:21a — They did not glorify Him as God, nor were they thankful.</u>

Consequences – 1:21b-22 –

#2.1 – They became futile in their thoughts.

#2.2 – Their foolish hearts were darkened.

#2.3 – Professing to be wise, they became fools.

## Round #3

Rejection — 1:23 — They changed the glory of the incorruptible God into an image made like corruptible man.

**Consequence** — 1:24 — God also gave them up to the uncleanness, in the lust of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves.

# The Consequences of Rejecting God's Truth

(Romans 1:18-2:10)

#### Round #4

**Rejection** — 1:25 — They exchanged the truth of God for the lie & worshiped & served the creature rather than the Creator.

<u>Consequences – 1:26-27</u> –

#4.1 – God gave them over to vile passions.

Example #1 – The women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature.

Example #2 – The men left the natural use of the woman.

#4.2 – They received in themselves the penalty of their error which was due.

#### Round #5

**Rejection** -1:28 – They did not like to retain God in their knowledge.

<u>Consequences – 1:28-32a & 32b – </u>

#5.1 – God gave them over to a debased mind, to do things that are not fitting; being filled with all unrighteousness.

#5.2 – Those who practice or approve of such things are deserving of death.

## Round #6

## The greatest warning of the 6 Rounds (Eternal)

#### <u>Rejection – 1:32-2:1</u> – They met the following criteria:

- #6.1 They are humans, meaning either men or women.
- #6.2 They know the righteous judgment of God and still judge others.
- #6.3 They judge others, yet practice the same sins as the people they are judging.
- #6.4 They despise the riches of God's goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering.

#### Consequences – 2:1-5 –

- #6.5 They are without excuse regarding God's judgment.
- #6.6 They will NOT escape the judgment of God.
- #6.7 They will experience God's wrath in the day of wrath. They treasured up God's wrath for themselves.
