Romans 3:20 to 5:2 Terminology

Term #1a - Faith (20 times)

What we trust in or believe in.

Term #1b - Believe (7 times)

What we trust in or believe in. The same root word as faith.

Term #2a - Righteousness (12 times)

"To be righteous" or "to be right" or "to be in a right standing with God".

Term #2b - Justify or Justified or Justifier or Justification (9 times)

This is the same word as "righteous" above, <u>but in the verb form</u>. In other words, it is the act of God making a person right or righteous.

Term #3 - Imputed or Accounted or Counted (12 times)

"To put..." or "to reckon/credit..." "...something to a person's account".

Term #4 – Redemption (1 time)

"To release something or someone through a payment." Or, "to liberate through the payment of a ransom".

Term #5 – Propitiation (1 time)

An elusive meaning. But it carries the concept of a person who <u>makes</u> <u>payment</u> or <u>gives compensation for a wrong committed</u>.
