

Romans 9 – Outline

(Justification has always been by faith – Including Israel)

9:1-7a – Paul opens up about his concern for the nation of Israel to come to the Lord by faith.

9:7b-29 – Four examples of people's rejection or acceptance of salvation by faith.

Example #1 – vv.7b-9 – Ishmael vs. Isaac.

Example #2 – vv.10-13 – Esau vs. Jacob.

Example #3 – vv.14-23 – Pharaoh vs. Moses.

Example #4 – vv.24-29 – Jews vs. Gentiles.

9:30-33 – Israel chose to try to earn salvation by keeping the Law of Moses.

They will pay for it if they don't come to faith in Jesus as so many Gentiles have.
