Discussion Questions

- Imagine yourself in Esther's position as queen after Mordecai told her of Haman's plan. How do you think you'd have responded?
- Think about a situation in your life right now that you're tempted to give in to fear or to not move forward. What is God saying to you through the message of Esther?
- Write out a prayer, asking God to give you greater courage to follow Him more fearlessly. Ask Him to show you a next step of faithful trust.
