## **Spiritual Warfare**

- A. What is spiritual warfare: The war between the spiritual forces of good versus the unseen forces of evil and darkness. The forces of evil desire to turn us away from God and strip us of our faith in Jesus Christ. Be mindful not to exaggerate the forces of evil nor underestimate their power. To exaggerate would be to blame the devil for everything. To underestimate is to lack knowledge of the truth from the Word of God that we are in a battle until Jesus returns or calls us home into heaven with Him. The good news is God gives us the remedy to live as the conquerors and overcomers that we already are in Christ Jesus.

# BACKGROUND OF THE TEXT: Famous Letter in which the Full Armor of God is derived. The Book of Ephesians.

What's Happening in Ephesus: The letter to the Ephesians is meant to be circulated among the churches in Asia Minor. While imprisoned in Rome, Paul heard of three major problems going on in Asia Minor to which he delivered solution, (1) there was confusion regarding whether or not gentiles should follow practices of the law and (2) need for unity-Jews and Gentiles alike are the body of Christ (3) the Ephesians and the other churches in Asia Minor were bothered by demonic forces. Paul is encouraging the Ephesians and the churches throughout Asia Minor in the truth, that there is no force greater than God! He let's the gospel of truth lead the victory through any battle! The majority of congregants in Ephesus were Gentile, and not of Jewish descent. (This is what Gentile means, not born of Jewish descent). There is but one body of Christ, the Church. They are included as one body.

# 3 Themes that point to courageous and powerful living for the Ephesians:

- 1. We are all one body in Christ, Jews and Gentiles alike. (Unity in Truth and Living).
- 2. We must walk out this unity, not in our own powers but in the Spirit of God.
- 3. We must put on the Spirit, just as a soldier put on his armor in order to battle the powers of this world.-This is why Paul writes the context of Scripture which contains the word picture of the The Full Armor of God. It is relational and puts a physical visual and understanding to the spiritual armor needed to win spiritual warfare.

**Ephesians 6:12 (NLT):** <sup>12</sup> For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places.

## Ephesians 6:12 (MSG): A Fight to the Finish

<sup>10-12</sup> And that about wraps it up. God is strong, and he wants you strong. So take everything the Master has set out for you, well-made weapons of the best materials. And put them to use so you will be able to stand up to everything the Devil throws your way. This is no weekend war that we'll walk away from and forget about in a couple of hours. This is for keeps, a life-or-death fight to the finish against the Devil and all his angels.

#### B. How do we Overcome:

- a. 2 Corinthians 10: 3-5 (NIV): <sup>2</sup>I beg you that when I come I may not have to be as bold as I expect to be toward some people who think that we live by the standards of this world. <sup>3</sup> For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. <sup>4</sup> The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. <sup>5</sup> We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.
  - i. We do not live by the standards of this world. We live according to the Word of God.
  - ii. **We fight with Spiritual armor** through the power of the Holy Spirit, who has divine power, meaning, beyond human ability- to demolish stronghold, everything designed to hold you captive.
  - iii. **The Word of God is our final authority:** we live, believe and fight according to the Word of God, not by personal opinion, worldly arguments, or societal status or impression.
- b. **God Focused and His Power:** Our focus should be on God, not demons; we speak to Him, not them. It is by His power, not ours that we execute authority.
  - i. Example: Michael the archangel did not rebuke Satan in his own power but said, "The Lord rebuke you!" Jude 1:9 (NIV): But even the archangel Michael, when he was disputing with the devil about the body of Moses, did not himself dare to condemn him for slander but said, "The Lord rebuke you!"
  - ii. **Darkness:** Do not open the door to darkness or deception: Today's society, especially the younger generation, they are opening themselves up to supernatural energies, crystals, wicken, white witches (claiming to be angels of light) and all other forms of demonic forces that invites spiritual warfare. Darkness is embraced and the Holy Spirit is mourned.

**Deception:** When we start talking to the devil, we run the risk of being led astray as Eve was as we witness in Genesis 3:1–7 (NIV): [READ AT HOME]3 Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?"

<sup>2</sup> The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden, <sup>3</sup> but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.'"

4 "You will not certainly die," the serpent said to the woman. 5 "For God knows that when you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

<sup>6</sup> When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it. <sup>7</sup> Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves.

- c. **Be Ready:** 1 Peter 5:8 (ESV): Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.
- d. **Submit to God:** James 4:7 (ESV): Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
  - i. Submit: Know the truth of God's Word. Let the Word of God become you.
  - ii. Resist: Be alert, aware, temptation is coming. Live out God's Word. Obey His ways. Our own sin and disobedience cause us harm, struggles and suffering. This is of our own doing when we fall into temptation. The devil brings the temptation, but God gives us the way of escape every time. 1 Corinthians 10:13. No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

James 1:13-14 (NLT): <sup>13</sup> And remember, when you are being tempted, do not say, "God is tempting me." God is never tempted to do wrong, <sup>[C]</sup> and he never tempts anyone else. <sup>14</sup> Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away.

e. Put on the Full Armor of God: Ephesians 6:13-17 (NLT): <sup>13</sup> Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. <sup>14</sup> Stand your ground,

putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness. <sup>15</sup> For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. <sup>16</sup> In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. <sup>[C]</sup> <sup>17</sup> Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

- i. Summary: What do these pieces of spiritual armor represent in spiritual warfare? We are to know the truth, believe the truth, and speak the truth. We are to rest in the fact that we are declared righteous because of Christ's sacrifice for us. We are to proclaim the gospel no matter how much resistance we face. We are not to waver in our faith, trusting God's promises no matter how strongly we are attacked. Our ultimate defense is the assurance we have of our salvation, an assurance that no spiritual force can take away. Our offensive weapon is the Word of God, not our own opinions and feelings. And we are to pray in the Spirit, and the power and will of the Holy Spirit.
  - **1. Pray in the Spirit:** Tongues: next week. The purity of God's will and His power.
  - 2. The Will of God: The Word of God is the will of God for your life and the truth in which the Holy Spirit guides our lives and activates within you and in this world.
- C. Live the Truth: What do You do after you say amen? We pray but then we must live out what we "say or confess" we believe. In other words, live as if you believe what you prayed.
  - **a.** James 1:21-22(NLT): So get rid of all the filth and evil in your lives, and humbly accept the word God has planted in your hearts, for it has the power to save your souls. But don't just listen to God's word. You must do what it says. Otherwise, you are only fooling yourselves.

### Lesson Summarized: READ AT HOME

In summary, what are the keys to success in spiritual warfare? We rely on God's power, not our own. We put on the whole armor of God. We draw on the power of Scripture—the Word of God is the Spirit's sword. We pray in perseverance and holiness, making our appeal to God. We stand firm (Ephesians 6:13–14); we submit to God; we resist the devil's work (James 4:7), knowing that the Lord of hosts is our protector. "Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will never be shaken" (Psalm 62:2).
