Shalom from Israel. I'm sure you've all heard about the attack on Israel from Iran. Now that attack was not unexpected.

In fact, we knew it was coming. But what was unexpected was the seriousness of that attack. Most of the experts expected that Iran would act not directly, meaning that the attack would not originate out of Iran. But Iran would use one of its proxies, for example, perhaps Hizballah in Lebanon, or perhaps the WHO team in Yemen, or one of their militias in Iraq. But in the end, the experts were not right. In fact, they anticipated a rather restraint attack. But this was not the case. We saw that last night 185 attack drones came out of Iran, as well as 36 cruise missiles. And here's what's also surprising 110 ballistic missiles, much greater response from Iran than anyone thought. But here's the good news. The Israeli air defense system, handled that attack in an unbelievable way. The experts said if Israel was able to deal with 80% of these rockets and drones, it would be a success. But in actuality, Israel was able to knock out of the sky 99% of those rockets and drones, amazing. And praise God for that. In the end, this is what this most serious attack brought to Israel, there was one military base that suffered very light damage to the infrastructure. And the most sad thing is this. There is a little seven year old Bedouin girl. And she was injured significantly critically. Because even though our rocket was, was knocked out of the sky, some shrapnel entered into her head, she has gone through surgery. But the doctors and I just heard this, the doctor said that her injuries are indeed life threatening. So there's a danger that she might die. Now, what can we do? Well as believers in that great physician, the Lord God of Israel, and his son, Messiah, sure, Jesus Christ, let's lift up this little seven year old Bedouin girl, that God would do a miracle, and heal her, and that she would have no lasting effect from what she suffered last night. With God, all things are possible. So please join me lifting her up. Now, I don't know her name, but but God knows who we're talking about. So pray for her, this seven year old Bedouin girl, that God would manifest his love to her and to her family, and that there would be a complete and quick recovery. Well, let me also share with you something, and that's this. When we look at the scripture, and I'm speaking about messiahs words from Mount of Olives, from Matthew 24, Mark 13, and Luke 21. He commands us to do something to watch the fig tree. And that fig tree is, of course, the nation of Israel. But when we look at a nother passage of scripture, and I'm speaking about the book of Daniel and chapter eight, we see something that there is what's known as the RAM. And the RAM is an empire, an evil empire. And we know its origin. Because in that eighth chapter, and by the way, that

eighth chapter is about the future. It doesn't point to the past. It's not about Antiochus epiphanies and in that transition within the Greek Empire, but But it's about the future. Read what that eighth chapter says in verses 17. And verses 98 clearly says that that vision is for the in times. And we find that in the last days, Iran is going to, and it's called per us when we die, per US is where we get the word Persia from. So it's clearly a reference to Iran. And we find that in the last days, there's going to be an Iranian led coalition. And this coalition is going to come out of the east and move to the north, the south and westward and bring about a great time of instability. And that's what we're seeing today. See, many people do not know that Iran is very active, for example, in Iraq, Iraq is a nation that because of the wars in the conflicts there, Iran has come into Iraq, and has great and significant influence in that nation. Likewise, when we look at Lebanon, by its proxy, Hezbollah, we find that Iran is really the power broker for Lebanon. And because of its close relationship with Syria, we find that Iran also is highly influential. In Syria. Also in Yemen, under the the terrorist organization, the hood team, we see that same thing, Iran's influence, but what you might not know is that Iran is actively working to bring about a regime change in Jordan. Iran wants King Abdullah out, and a more radical, and a Shiite led government to replace him. And perhaps that's why that King Abdullah, that he participated, and he did something, he used his military, to knock out many of those attack drones as they came into Jordan, and Israel is very thankful for this. And again, praise God. For that, as you're watching that, I want to share with you one more piece of information. And that is this. I hear so frequently, and we get emails about how it's really Israel that is provoking Iran, with all of Israel's attacking of Iranian assets in Syria and other places. Well, here's what I would say in response to that. That is so disingenuous, why? What is Iran doing, Iran is bringing more and more weapons into Syria. Why? Because they want to wage war against Israel, from Syria. And again, they also want to see Jordan switch, and King Abdullah and his administration be replaced with one that is more favorable to the Iranian government. And therefore, they want to take control of Lebanon, Syria, and Jordan, the two of them, they already control, Lebanon and Syria, they want Jordan as well, in order to push Israel into the sea. This is what the Iranians are saying. So it's not so much Israel provoking Iran, but Iran in bringing in military assets and weapons, and and leaders, military leaders. This is why Israel acted and attack that annex near the the Iranian embassy in Damascus, because a leader, a general, in a very significant Brigade of the Iranian army was there. And Israel sent a clear message, and that's

what needs to be done, that they are not going to tolerate Iranian influence in Syria from a military standpoint. And unfortunately, the world doesn't get it. And we need to remain in this war until the objectives have been made. And those objectives are to destroy Hamas, and bring home the hostages that are still alive. That's very important, but we need to do it in the right order and the right way. And that means Unfortunately, things are not going to get easier in Gaza. But there must become more difficult and be assured of something when that situation is truly dire. And it's not now I know what the government say the United Nations say and such. But it's simply not the case. When there is truly massive hunger there and truly a shortage of food. You're going to see a rebellion against come us. A Senator Lindsey Graham asked a government official is Israel using food as a weapon? My hope is that we are it can be a very very powerful weapon. And if you study war, you use all things to bring the enemy to defeat and that key, unconditional surrender. Now I know I've spoken about this in the past, but so many people don't get it. And therefore, when there is a conclusion, a scene of hostility without the war ending properly, what happens? That conflict goes and goes, and goes, we need to fight wars, and fight them harshly, to bring about a quick end. And let me conclude with this. America went to war against Afghanistan. When America began that war, it was the Taliban in power. And that war was 19 years and costs \$2.3 trillion. And when America pulled out and left, the Taliban was back in power. What I'm saying is this, we need to learn how to win wars. And unfortunately, today, if you follow what the United Nations say, if you follow what the world believes, is the proper way to wage war, you don't get justice. You don't get a righteous conclusion. What you get is a premature ceasing of hostility, which ends up leaving the residents of of that country in a very bad situation. We need change, and we need a godly change. And my firm opinion is this. Israel wants to bring change to Gaza. Israel needs to administer Gaza. And if so the quality of life will improve for all the citizens of Gaza. Israel is not against the people of Gaza, or those who proclaim that they are Palestinians. But we are not going to tolerate terrorism. And the first step towards that righteous pursuit is destroying Hamas, and then afterwards, going up to Lebanon and also into Syria, in order to destroy his Bala that has to be done.
