

# #1, Jesus & Nicodemus

John 3:1-21, Ezekiel 36:25-27

Today we're starting a new series. It's a 6-week series called, *ONE*! It's a teaching series built around the times where we see Jesus talking with just *ONE* person. Even with the massive reach of Jesus' ministry, the gospels reveal over 40 interactions that He had with just *ONE* person. Jesus came, by his own admission, to seek and to save the lost person. It's going to be a great series... Let's get started!

#### John 3:1-3

- Nicodemus was a man of high authority in the religious community.
  - He was a member of the Sanhedrin and therefore, an influential leader in the community.
    - Because of his position of influence and authority, He came to Jesus at night.
- Isn't it true that all of us approach Jesus under the cover of darkness our own darkness!
  - o Don't be ashamed to come to Jesus with whatever is happening in your life!
    - Nicodemus is clearly rocked back on his heels by Jesus' response because it brutally exposed his spiritual need!!

## John 3:4

- I love how Jesus uses an uncommon phrase to throw Nicodemus out of his religious rhythm.
  - Nicodemus is probably thinking:
    - I can learn more, I can memorize more and, I can follow more rules
      - But be born, AGAIN?

We cannot <u>SEE</u> the Kingdom of God! (Unless BORN AGAIN)
We cannot ENTER the Kingdom of God (Unless BORN OF WATER & the SPIRIT!)

# John 3:5-13

Jesus takes Nicodemus to an OT passage that He would have understood about water and spirit.

#### Ezekiel 36:25

25 I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. 26 And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. 27 And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.

- #1. The act of becoming born again involves the washing of our hearts from all uncleanness!
- #2. The act of becoming born again involves being given a new heart a heart that lives again.
- #3. The act of becoming born again involves the infilling of the Spirit to walk in his ways!

# Jesus doesn't come into your life to inform you about what you've done wrong!

## But rather, to <u>transform</u> you into the person that you're called to be!

- God puts a living Spirit in us, which shapes and gives character to our new hearts!
  - o God takes out the heart of stone and puts in a heart of flesh.
    - It means having a soft, living and responsive heart instead of a lifeless brick for a heart!

#### John 3:14-15

- But, not everyone, though bitten and filled with poison, wanted to look at the bronze serpent to experience life and healing! (Numbers 21:1-9)
  - o In the same way, only those <u>that look and believe</u> in the lifted cross of Christ will have eternal life!
    - He had to take on Himself the sting of death.
      - He had to take on Himself the poison of sin on the cross.

#### John 3:16-20

- Jesus didn't come to make your life horrible and miserable!
  - o He came to change you life and set you free... Jesus came into the world to save people!
    - Just as the Israelites could look to the uplifted bronze serpent and be saved, we can look to Jesus!

# What do we learn from this conversation with Nicodemus?

### 1.) We can come to Jesus in our darkness!

- We don't have to clean up, get all fixed up... Come as you are!
  - Whatever your issue... whatever your pain... Come to Jesus...

## 2.) It is the person of Christ and not our position in life that brings us peace!

- Nothing in this life will bring lasting peace!
  - Your position cannot bring you peace!

# 3.) You are really born again when you truly believe!

- 7x he uses the word, BELIEVE!
  - Salvation is received through belief

## John 3:21

But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in God!

There is a LIGHT that SHINES in the Darkness... HIS NAME IS JESUS!

**RECEIVE CHRIST!**
