

Memory Verses at the Village Church for 2023

January- LOVE

1) John 13: 34- A new commandment I give you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

[Love one another as I have loved you.]

8) John 14: 15- If you love Me you will keep My commandments.

15) 1 Peter 4: 8- Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins.

[Love covers a lot of sins.]

22) Matthew 5: 44- But this I say to you- love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you.

[Love your enemies.]

29) 1 John 5: 3- For this is the love of God, that you keep His commandments; and His commandments are not burdensome.

[God's commandments are not too hard.]

February- Salvation

5) Matthew 7: 13- Enter through the narrow gate, for the way is broad that leads to destruction and there are many that enter through it.

[Enter through the narrow gate.]

12) Matthew 7: 14- For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.

[The way to life is narrow.]

19) Acts 16: 31- Believe in the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved.

26) 1 John 2: 3- By this we know that we have come to know Him, if we keep His commandments.

[We know that we know Him if we keep His commandments.]

March- Witness

5) Matthew 28: 19-20 NLT Therefore go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this- [I am with you always.]

12) 1 Peter 3: 15- You must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it. But do this in a gentle and respectful way.

[Be gentle and respectful.]

19) Colossians 4: 5 NLT Live wisely among those who are not believers, and make the most of every opportunity.

[Live wisely in the world.]

26) Colossians 4: 6- Let your speech always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person.

[Say kind words to others.]

April- Prayer

2) Matthew 6: 7- And when you are praying, do not use meaningless repetition as the Gentiles do, for they suppose that they will be heard for their many words.

[When you pray, don't keep saying the same words.]

9) Matthew 7: 7 NLT- Ask and keep on asking and it will be given to you. Seek and keep on seeking and you will find. Knock and keep on knocking and it will be opened to you.

[Ask God for what you need.]

16) Luke 18: 1- Now He was telling them a parable to show that at all times they ought to pray and not lose heart.

[Always pray and don't give up!]

23) Ephesians 6: 18- With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance for all the saints.

[Pray at all times for everyone.]

30) Colossians 4: 2- Devote yourselves to prayer, keeping alert in it with an attitude of thanksgiving.

[When you pray, thank God.]

May- Doing My Job

7) Ephesians 4: 28- He who steals must steal no longer, but rather he must labor, performing with his own hands what is good so that he will have something to share with one who has need.

[Don't steal, share!]

14) Colossians 3: 17- Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

[Do all you do as Jesus would.]

21) Colossians 3: 23- Whatever you do, do your work heartily, as for the Lord rather than for men.

[Do all you do for God, not people.]

28) Colossians 3: 24- Knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance. It is the Lord Christ whom you serve!

[Jesus will reward us for our service to Him.]

June- Body

4) 1 Corinthians 12: 18- But now God has placed the members, each one of them in the body, just as He desired.

[Each part of Christ's body is in the right place.]

11) Ephesians 4: 15- But speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ.

[Speak the truth in love.]

18) Ephesians 4: 16- From whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

[Everyone doing their part makes God's body grow.]

25) 1 Peter 4: 10- As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

[Use your special gift!]

July- Family

2) Ephesians 5: 25- Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her.

[Husbands, love your wives.]

9) Ephesians 5: 33b- And the wife must see to it that she respects her husband.

[Wives, respect your husbands.]

16) Ephesians 6: 1- Children, obey your parents in the Lord for this is right.

[Children, obey your parents.]

23) Ephesians 6: 2- Honor your father and mother, which is the first commandment with a promise.

[Honor your Mom and Dad.]

30) Ephesians 6: 4- Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

[Fathers, don't frustrate your child.]

August- Fear

6) Matthew 6: 34- Do not worry about tomorrow for tomorrow will take care of itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

[Do not worry about tomorrow.]

13) 1 Peter 5: 7- Casting all your care on Him for He cares for you.

20) 1 John 4: 18- There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear..

[Perfect love casts out fear.]

27) Philippians 4: 6- Don't worry about anything, instead pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank Him for all He has done.

[Don't worry- pray.]

September- Finances

3) Matthew 6: 19- Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal.

[Do not store up treasures on earth.]

10) Matthew 6: 20- But store up for yourselves treasures in Heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.

[Store up treasure in Heaven.]

17) 2 Corinthians 9: 7 NLT- You must each decide in your heart how much to give, and don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure, for God loves a person who gives cheerfully.

[God loves a cheerful giver.]

24) 1 Timothy 6: 17 NLT- Teach those who are rich in this world not to be proud and not to trust in their money, which is so unreliable. Their trust should be in God, who richly gives us all we need for our enjoyment.

[Don't trust in money, trust God.]

October- Satan

1) Ephesians 6: 11- Put on the full armor of God so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.

[Put on the whole armor of God.]

8) James 4: 7- Submit to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you.

15) 1 Peter 5: 8,9a- Be sober, be alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion seeking someone to devour. Resist him, firm in your faith.

[Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion- resist him.]

22) Ephesians 6: 16- In all circumstances, take up the shield of faith with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one.

[Take up the shield of faith.]

29) Ephesians 5: 26-27- Be angry and yet do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger and do not give the devil a foothold.

[Be angry but don't sin.]

November- Priorities

5) Matthew 6: 33- Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness and all these things will be added to you.

[Seek God's kingdom.]

12) Ephesians 5: 15-16- Therefore be careful how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise, making the most of your time because the days are evil.

[Make the most of your time.]

19) Romans 12: 2- Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

[Prove what God's will is.]

26) 1 Timothy 4: 7b and 8- Discipline yourself for the purpose of godliness, for bodily discipline is only of little profit, but godliness is profitable for all things since it holds promise for the present life and the life to come.

[Train yourself in godliness.]

December- Good works that come from a relationship with God

3) Matthew 5: 16- Let your light shine in such a way that they may see your good works and glorify your Father who is in Heaven.

[Let Jesus' light shine in you.]

10) Galatians 6: 9- Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary.

[Don't give up doing good.]

17) Galatians 6: 10- So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.

[Let's do good to all people.]

24) Hebrews 10: 24- Let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds.

[Help others to know how to love.]

31) Hebrews 13: 16- And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.

[Do good and share.]
