Discuss Vs 13–24 • Two disciples are leaving town after the disaster of Jesus’ arrest and crucifixion. Put yourself in their sandals. What is their mood & mindset?

Application • As we see in these two on the road to Emmaus, folks often “walk away” from Jesus because of hard circumstances, confusions, church drama, disappointments, and a host of other reasons.

Discuss • How do you “see” Jesus most clearly—as the anchor for your faith?

Luke 24:25–32 • Jesus reveals Himself in the scriptures

The most amazing Bible study in all of history! Jesus took these two disciples on a “journey” through the Old Testament, showing all of the prophecies and pictures of Himself divinely inspired hundreds and thousands of years earlier. Here are a few examples of HIS RESURRECTION seen in the Old Testament Jesus likely explained—

Abraham & Isaac • His Resurrection is seen in Genesis 22:3–6 _____
_____ (Heb. 11:19)

King David • Jesus Resurrection is seen Psalm 16:8–11. Peter explains

this in Acts 2:22–36. _____

Jonah • Jesus compares 3 days and nights in the tomb to Jonah in the belly of the fish (Matthew 12:40).

Luke 24:33–40 • **Jesus reveals Himself in the breaking of the bread**

The disciples return to Jerusalem to report their experience to the disciples in the upper room. Jesus joins them! And He shows the scars in His hands and feet: *leading us to our **Communion Service**.*

Discuss • *God give us tangible, simple elements of bread and wine to connect with Jesus, yet our spiritual life was birthed His supernatural Word, the divine, holy, inspired scriptures! Why do we need BOTH?*
