## **"Crouching"** Genesis 4:1–16 Mt Lassen Community Church • June 29, 2025

Intro • What are the most minor, silly things that drive you nuts?

**Vs 1–5** • Why does God regard Abel's offering, but not Cain's? Several reasons: Cain was...

- ...in the flesh James 3:14–16 & 4:1–2
- ...unrepentant 1 John 3:8, 10–13
- ...lacked faith Hebrews 11:4

**Discuss** • Review the above passages. What light do they shed on the story of Cain & Abel?

Did God reject Cain's offering because it was *grain* and not *an animal*? **Possibly**—but offerings in scripture can be grain or meat. **Better** → Abel brought the *first* of his flocks, but Cain brought grain *"in the course of time"* (meaning, not the first of the harvest, but the last!) Their offerings represent the condition of their HEART & their FAITH!

**Discuss** • Why do you think God rejected Cain's offering—and how did they know which was accepted and which was rejected?

**Vs 6** • "Why are you angry"—Cain might say, "because you didn't receive my offering," but it was actually *jealous rage, sin, lack of faith, etc.* → The reason you THINK you are angry is probably NOT the correct answer! There is surely a DEEPER reason to uproot from your heart!

**Vs 7** • "Do well, and master the crouching beast" = God gave Cain a chance to quit! **Problem:** Cain *knew* the beast was there! His anger is building; he is jealous; he is thinking hateful thoughts. This is all *premeditated*. **Lesson:** Cain DOWNPLAYED the danger of the beast at the door! Instead of an *enemy*, Cain saw an *excuse* to murder!

How we "master" our prone-to-sin flesh-

If you are **spiritually dead** – then the FLESH influences the mind by passions and desires—

But if you are **spiritually alive**, then your spiritual nature rules over your mind, which can then rule over the flesh—

## SPIRIT $\rightarrow$ MIND & WILL $\rightarrow$ PASSIONS & DESIRES FLESH

So, in Christ, sin no longer holds the predominate place of influence over our minds, but rather the Holy Spirit! But the FLESH is still present and inherently wants to sin. So, we MUST and CAN master it by the SPIRIT!

Go deeper • These scriptures tell us how can walk in the Spirit and tame the flesh → Ephesians 4:20–24 • Galatians 5:16 • 1 Corinthians 9:25–27 • Philippians 3:12–14 • Romans 12:2 • 1 Peter 1:3–4 • Hebrews 4:12 • Galatians 2:20 • Romans 8:11

**Vs 8–9** • God is THERE, but Cain still commits murder! Be warned: we must nip temptation in the bud the moment it sprouts. Don't let it grow!

Vs 10 • Jesus' blood cries out FOR us, not against us (like Abel's)

**Vs 11–14** • Cain is sorrowful over his punishment, not his sin! This isn't true repentance.

**Vs 15** • God gives Cain mercy—a mark of protection (an expensive gift of grace paid for at the Cross of Jesus)...

Vs 16 • ...but sadly, Cain still leaves the presence of the LORD.
