**Intro** • How has God provided for you? What are you most grateful for?

Genesis 22:1–2 • "Your only son, whom you love, Isaac" → Jesus will come through Isaac, not Ishmael, to bless the whole world.
"Moriah" • same location as the future in Jerusalem
& the same mount as, where Jesus died
"Burnt offering" • Human sacrifices were an abomination to God—how
is this possible? Spoiler alert:
Vs 3-5 • "We will return" • Hebrews 11:19 gives important info:

<b>"Worship"</b> • This is the first use of "worship" in scripture—and it is not
about singing or praising: it is about
Vs 6 ◆ Three connections to the Cross:
Vs 7–8 • God will provide a sacrifice
<b>Vs 9–13</b> • The worst moment in Abraham's life to the best moment!
Vs 13–14 • Jehovah Jireh, "God our Provider"—What is the PRIMARY
providence of God? $\rightarrow$
The Ram in the Thicket • The picture changes. Now Isaac is

The KEY idea of the Atonement is "He died in my place, taking my punishment". There are other meanings in the Cross in scripture. For example, He died—

- —as an example 1 Peter 2:21
- -to triumph over Satan victoriously Colossians 2:15 & Hebrews 2:14
- <u>to purchase us from sin's slavery; our ransom & redemption</u> 1 Peter 1:18 & Mark 10:45
- —as a demonstration of God's love Romans 5:8
- → But these all build upon the foundation of Jesus dying as our Substitute, taking the penalty of sin in our place. (The theological term: Penal Substitutionary Atonement; "PSA")

More scriptures: Romans 3:25; Romans 5:6–8 Corinthians 5:21; Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 2 Hebrews 7:26–27; Hebrews 9:22 & 27–28; He	:13–14; 1 Peter 2:24;
Cosmic Child Abuse? Did God the Father abu	se His Son at the Cross???
NO → Jesus' physical suffering was inflicted by	oy , not God!
But God Jesus' against His holiness. (Acts 2:26–38; 4:25–28)	

What we meant for evil, God meant for good! (Gen. 50:20)

Closing: Genesis 22:15–18 • Like Abraham, God did not withhold His only Son from us! And like Abraham, we can trust God even when it is hard, even when it doesn't make sense.
