The Ancient City of Sardis (Rev. 3:1)

**How Jesus Introduced Himself (Rev. 3:1a;** cf. Rev. 1:4-5; 4:5; 5:6; Zech. 4:10; Isaiah 11:2)

Jesus' Diagnosis of the Church in Sardis (Rev. 3:1b-2)

Gk. νεκρός<sup>a</sup>, ά, όν: pertaining to being dead—'lifeless, dead.'

Gk. **πληροφορέω**<sup>a</sup>; πληρόω: "fulfilled" or "fully completed"

## Jesus' Remedy & Challenge for Christians in Sardis (Rev. 3:2)

Gk. γρηγορέ $\omega^a$ : to remain awake because of the need to continue alert—'to stay awake, to be watchful"

Gk. στηρίζω<sup>a</sup>; ἐπιστηρίζω; στερεόω<sup>b</sup>: to cause someone to become stronger in the sense of more firm and unchanging <u>in attitude or belief</u>"]

## Four Calls (R's) to Action:

1. R (Rev. 3:2)

Gk. γρηγορέ $\omega^a$ : to remain awake because of the need to continue alert—'to stay awake, to be watchful.

**2**. **R** (**Rev. 3:3**; cf. Matt. 24:43)

Gk. μετανοέω; μετάνοια, ας f: to change one's way of life as the result of a complete change of thought and attitude with regard to sin and righteousness

**3.** Rev. 1:3) (Rev. 3:3; cf. Heb. 12:1-3;

Gk. μνημονεύω<sup>a</sup>; μιμνήσκομαι<sup>a</sup>; μνήμη, ης f; μνεία<sup>a</sup>, ας f: to recall or refocus on information from memory, but without necessarily the implication that persons have actually forgotten

**4.** R (Rev. 3:4; cf. Matt. 24:13; Phil. 4:9; 1 Cor. 9:26-27; Gal. 6:9; Col. 2:6; 2 Tim. 4:7; Heb. 10:36; Jas. 1:22-23; Rev. 1:3)

Gk. "follow/keep"--  $\tau \eta \rho \dot{\epsilon} \omega^a$ : to cause a state to continue—'to cause to continue, to retain, to keep.'

Gk. περιπατέω $^{\rm a}$ : to walk along or around—'to walk, to go.' περιπατῶν
