Genesis 17:1–8 • Review from Sunday

Vs 9–14 • Circumcision is introduced

Originates with Abraham, not Moses (Romans 4:8–13)
Connects with Abrahams' story
• A private sign
• For infants
• Other meanings: Deut. 10:15 & 30:6 • God will circumcision your hearts "The Circumcision" • those who enforce the Law of Moses legalistically Ex. 6:12 • "uncircumcised lips" (faltering speech) Jer 6:10 • "uncircumcised ears" (won't listen to God) Phil. 3:3 / Rom 2:29 • Christians are the "True Circumcision"

Ch. 18:1–8 • Abraham practices hospitality to guests: God & 2 angels! _

Vs 9–15 • God reveals His plan for Sarah to bear a child	Vs 2–5 • The unbridled lust of Sodom (Gen 13:13)

Abraham's laugh (Gen 17:17)	Does Ezek. 16:49–50 redefine the sin of Sodom to being "inhospitable"?
Sarah's laugh in 18:13

Sarah's laugh in ch 21	Gen 19:6–8 • Lot negotiates for the angel's safety—in a despicable way!
	(compare to Judges 19:20–24)
Ishmael's mocking laugh in ch 21	
(Gal 4:28–29)	Vs 9−11 • Graphic illustration of the devastating effect of unchecked sin
Vs 16–22 • God reveals his plan for Sodom's destruction to Abraham	Vs 12–14 • Lot's sons–in–law ignore his warning of judgment
	"Outcry"
Vs 23–33 • God and Abraham negotiate for Sodom's preservation—if	
only 10 righteous people are found, God will relent	
	Vs 15–28 • Sunday's Sermon!
