Intro • God used a burning bush to get Moses’ attention. What, or whom, did God use to grab your attention—turning your heart to Him?

Discussion • Review together the rich meaning of each holy item below...

Exodus 3:1–3 • **Holy Fire** _____

Make it your prayer: Lord, send your Holy Fire upon me—to draw all eyes to You!

Vs 4–6 • **Holy Ground** _____

Make it your prayer: Lord, don’t let me ever trust in my own works, but only in Yours! Help me connect directly with you, removing all pretense, hypocrisy, religiosity, or vain human efforts.

Vs 7–10 • **Holy Mission** _____

Make it your prayer: Lord, you saw our helpless condition of bondage, and you came to set us free. Help us to see others in need with the same eyes and compassion. Move us to action.

Vs 11–15 • **Holy Name**

Moses declares himself the “Great I Ain’t” — God declares Himself to be the great “I AM”

God’s primary name: “I AM” _____

“I AM has sent me” _____

In Genesis, God is primarily revealed as “El Shaddai” _____

Starting in Exodus, God is primarily revealed as “Yahweh” _____

Vs 16–19 • **Holy Mission** (repeated) _____

Vs 20–22 • **Holy Grace** _____

God gives His people the treasure of Egypt as they depart. They aren’t just “barely saved” from Egypt—they are saved richly; above and beyond. This is GRACE → we are saved unto ABUNDANT LIFE!

Prov. 6:31 • a thief must pay back 7x

Isaiah 61:7 • instead of shame & humiliation, we get a “double portion”

Joel 2:25–26 • God returns the stolen years

Job 42:10 • The LORD restores Job’s stolen fortune, increasing 2x

Isaiah 54:17 • We will condemn the tongue that accuses
