Context • Judah in Genesis 38 seems out of place. But we can more fully appreciate Joseph's success in Genesis 39 because Judah stands in stark moral contrast to Joseph.	Temptation can't get stronger if we <i>never</i> budge or compromise BTW • Joseph is presented as sinless in scripture (even though he is not!) → in his "perfection" Joseph points us to Jesus!

2 • he is mindful of the "great evil" of violating the marriage covenant; _	Key: We don't win by fixating on the temptation—we win by fixating on the Cross of Christ!
