#### **SCRIPTURE:**

John 13:34-35

<sup>34</sup> "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. <sup>35</sup> By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

# 1 Corinthians 13:1-3

<sup>1</sup>If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. <sup>2</sup> If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. <sup>3</sup> If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

#### **Sermon Points:**

## **5 Questions Asked During Band Meetings**

- 1. What known sins have you committed since our last meeting?
- 2. What temptations have you met with?
- 3. How were you delivered?
- 4. What have you thought, said, or done, of which you doubt whether it be sin or not?
- 5. Have you nothing you desire to keep secret?

#### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- 1. Ask your kids or a kid the question, "What is love?" Share the answer(s) with your Group. Which definition did you like best and why?
- 2. Who is the hardest person for you to love and why?
- 3. In what ways has our culture watered down what love really is?
- 4. How are people's actions different when love is the motivation? (See 1 Corinthians 13:1-3)
- 5. Who is the person in your life who loves you enough to tell you the truth?
- 6. Have you ever been in a Group that was like the "Band" John talked about this morning? If yes, then what impact did that Group or "Band" have on your life?
- 7. What is one thing God spoke to your heart today? What is God calling you to do in response to what you heard?
- Action Steps: Step up and serve as the Apprentice for your Group and commit to starting a NEW Group at GroupLink in January and/or start a "Band" with 3-5 other men or women and begin meeting weekly to discuss the 5 questions.
