

The Power of Connection - Sunday, November 4th

SCRIPTURE:

Ecclesiastes 4:9-12

Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up. Also, if two lie down together, they will keep warm. But how can one keep warm alone? Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves. A cord of three strands is not quickly broken.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How old were you when you first experienced peer pressure?

- 2. When did you first become aware that drugs were not just an issue "out there" but also right here in our community?
- 3. How can "unconditional acceptance, belonging, support, encouragement and accountability" help an addict?
- 4. How is the power of connection both preventative and restorative when it comes to addiction (See Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 and Hebrews 10:24-25)?
- 5. What is one thing you learned about Mark Wittig's soccer ministry going on in Colombia today? What is one thing you can do to help make a difference?
- 6. What was your first reaction when you learned about this year's Big Give theme and recipients?
- 7. What is one thing God spoke to your heart today? What is God calling you to do in response to what you heard?
