"Two Trips to the Temple"
(Luke 18:9-14)

Contribute to the discussion if you feel led to share! Use of Scripture is encouraged!

- 1) How does the parable's emphasis on heart attitude over outward actions challenge our understanding of what it means to be truly religious?**
- 2) How might our motivations for attending church compare to those of the Pharisee and the tax collector in the parable? What can we learn from examining our own hearts before worship?**
- 3) In what ways might we unintentionally display a 'holier-than-thou' attitude like the Pharisee, and how can we cultivate genuine humility in our spiritual lives?**
- 4) What does it mean to approach God with true reverence and how can we cultivate this attitude in our daily lives and worship?**

Take Home/Challenge Question:

- 1) Reflect on your motivations for serving in church or doing good deeds. Are they driven by a desire to be seen by others or out of genuine love for God?**
- 2) Consider how you can make your church attendance more meaningful, focusing on genuine worship and openness to God's work in your life.**
