May was a good month at FCABC. How wonderful it was to Baptize those 7 precious souls on May 18th. Congratulations to them on their Baptism and Praise be to our Lord!

As we move into June you can feel the excitement already for our Vacation Bible School that will occur June 16th thru 20th. We will be learning a great deal about magnifying our Lord.

I don't have to tell any of you how important VBS is, think about the name "Bible School". This is kids learning the bible. So, so important!

I found this little story last week: The new minister was asked to teach a young boys' class in the absence of the regular teacher. He decided to see what they knew about the bible, so he asked who knocked down the walls of Jericho. All the boys denied having done it, and the preacher was appalled by their ignorance. At the next deacons' meeting he told about the experience. "Not one of them knows who knocked down the walls of Jericho," he lamented. The group was silent until finally one seasoned veteran of disputes spoke up. "Preacher, this appears to be bothering you a lot. But I've known all those

boys since they were born and they're good boys. If they said they didn't know who did it, I believe them. Let's just take some money out of the building fund, fix the walls, and let it go at that." LOL

However, kids learning the Bible is no laughing matter. Based on data from Lifeway Research, "The single greatest influence over spiritual health is regular Bible reading while growing up. Plainly put, the parents of young adults indicate that regular Bible reading as children yields the greatest influence over their spiritual health."

A study by Dr. George Barna and printed by K-Love in 2024 found that only 60% of children in America have read even part of the Bible, only 21% of children believe in absolute moral truth and that approximately 36% of 8-12 year olds believe that confession and asking Jesus for forgiveness is the means to salvation.

"My research shows that a person's worldview is essentially formed by the age of 13, making the preteen years (ages 8 to 12) the critical window for helping children build a faith that will last a lifetime. The beliefs and values put into place during these years will define them for the rest of their

lives." (Dr. George Barna)

Paul told Timothy in 2 Timothy 3:14-15, "¹⁴ But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned *them*, ¹⁵ and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."

Pray, Pray, Pray for VBS and invite as many to come as you can.


