## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) The sermon describes God's love as having width, length, depth, and height—an immeasurable, boundless love. **How does understanding this immeasurable nature of God's love change the way you view your own worth?**
- 2) We learned that God's love is wide enough to embrace the world, long enough to last forever, high enough to take sinners to heaven, and deep enough to reach the lowest sinner. **Which dimension of God's love do you struggle most to comprehend or accept personally?**
- 3) Paul was a praying man in every circumstance—revival, persecution, shipwreck, or imprisonment. **How can you develop a lifestyle of constant prayer rather than treating prayer as an occasional activity?**
- 4) Paul prays that believers would be 'strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man.' **What is the difference between outward strength and inner spiritual strength, and which do you prioritize?**

## Take Home/Challenge Questions:

- 1) The sermon states that the devil lies about our worthlessness while God declares our immense worth through His love. **Which voice do you find yourself listening to more often, and what specific steps can you take to reject the lies?**
