The Bible says in Ezekiel 22:30, "sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it; but I found no one."

What would God do with you and I if we would totally make ourselves available to Him.

In 1873 D.L. Moody heard the Rev Henry Varley said, "The world has yet to see what God will do with and for and through the man who is fully and wholly consecrated to Him." After which Dwight Lyman Moody prayed, "By God's help, I want to be that man."

Another more recent reminder of what God can do with one person committed to Him is Charlie Kirk. He applied to the U.S. Military Academy at West Point but was rejected in 2012. He was accepted to Baylor University in Waco TX, but chose to enroll at Harper Community College in Palatine, IL. He dropped out after one semester. In 2015. Kirk was enrolled part-time at King's College in NY, where he took online

classes. He never received a college degree during his lifetime, a fact he often mentioned during his debates with academic students.

In 2012 he co-founded Turning Point USA when he was 18 years old and used this platform and his debate opportunities to spread the message of Jesus Christ and conservative, biblical principles.

He said, regarding Christianity in America, "The body politic of America was so Christian and was so Protestant that our form and structure of government was built for the people that believed in Christ our Lord."

Last week over 100 million people (number continues to rise) watched the Charlie Kirk Memorial Service, over 90,000 were in attendance and hundreds stood to received Christ as their Savior. With the phrases "revival and Jesus Christ" mentioned over and over throughout the entire service.




YOUTH UPDATES Verse of the month:
