"Wet Wood Will Work"

(1 Kings 18:16-40)

**-1)** Obadiah feared God but was also actively serving an evil king. His loyalty between God and the world was divided. He was straddling the fence. **How do we avoid straddling the fence between living for God and living for the world? How do we fully live for God?**

**-2)** Read verse 21. David pointed out that there are people in our community who are hurting and need the gospel. Trying to live for God and the world can hinder us. How does a life fully lived for God affect the potential impact we can have on those around us?

**-3)** Many in our culture today are watering down the gospel. What are some of the major false teachings you have heard or seen that we need to be on guard against today?

**-4)** How do we avoid our faith becoming "watered down"?

This week, take time each day to pray for revival. Pray for a revival in your heart. Pray for a revival in our church, our nation, and this world. Pray that God's Spirit would overflow and that God's love, justice, and mercy would flood this earth.
