- -1) What consequences fall on the nation of Israel as a result of listening to the ten fear-filled spies? Should we expect there to be consequences in our own lives if we walk in fear instead of faith?
- -2) In the face of fear, it can be easy to lose sight of God's plan. In 13:2, we see that God makes his plan clear to give the land of Canaan to the Israelites. When we are faced with fear, how can we fix our minds on God's promises? What are your favorite promises of God?
- -3) The Israelites placed God's ability to conquer the Promised Land outside of their parameters of belief. What limitations or parameters have you placed on God? How can we stop ourselves from placing limitations on God?
- -4) Read Numbers 14:5. How can a prayerful, humble heart-posture shape our new year? What are ways you can adopt this heart-posture into your life this year?

## Take Home/Challenge Question:

-Even though they were in the minority, Joshua and Caleb stood up for what was right. What are ways that you can stand up for God's Kingdom amongst your friends, family, and acquaintances this year (even if you are in the minority)?
