(Mark 16:1-7)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) The women in Mark 16 expected to find a dead body despite Jesus telling His disciples He would rise on the third day. **What 'stones' or obstacles does doubt place between us and fully believing God's promises? What should we do if we are experiencing doubts?**
- 2) Christianity is described as the only religion founded on a resurrected leader rather than a dead one. **How does the literal, physical resurrection of Jesus fundamentally change everything about our faith and daily living?**
- 3) The same Holy Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead dwells in believers according to Romans 8:11. **How should this truth practically impact the way we face challenges, fears, and hardships in life?**
- 4) The sermon states that approximately 6 billion people in the world still do not believe in Jesus' resurrection. **What responsibility do believers have to 'go tell' this message, and who is your specific person or people?**

Take Home/Challenge Questions:

- 1) David asked, 'How is the resurrection of Jesus really, truly realized in your personal life?' **How would you honestly answer this question about your own faith journey right now?**
- 2) Romans 6:4 says we should 'walk in newness of life' just as Christ was raised from the dead. **What area of your life needs to be resurrected or made new through the power of the living Christ?**
