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As we enter the month of Hebrews 10:24-25 says, "And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching."

September often feels like a fresh beginning. Summer vacations are winding down, kids are back into school routines, and many of our church ministries are beginning a new season of activity.

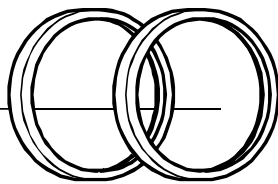
