- -3) Why is it important to recognize that spiritual warfare is going on all around us and affects our lives every day?
- -4) Read Matthew 26:41. Why is it important that we "watch" and "pray"? What can "watching" and "praying" look like for us on a daily basis?

Take Home/Challenge Question:

Have you ever truly internalized that Jesus died specifically for your sins? That your sins nailed Him to the cross. That God had to pour out wrath onto Jesus for the sins you specifically committed. Take some time to thank Jesus for dying for your sins.
