2) **Paul warns in 1 Corinthians 11 against partaking of the Lord's Supper in an unworthy manner (irreverently or carelessly).** What practices or attitudes might help you approach communion with greater intentionality and reverence?

3) The Corinthian church struggled to separate their old cultural habits from their new life in Christ, much like believers today. **What are some areas where the patterns of the world most subtly threaten to corrupt the fellowship and worship of the modern church?**

4) Galatians 2:20 speaks of being crucified with Christ and yet still living. **How does the concept of dying to self connect to what communion is meant to proclaim. What does it look like for us to die to ourselves?**
