DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Contribute to the discussion if you feel led to share! Use of Scripture is encouraged!

- -1) Moses gave up the wealth and power of Egypt to follow God and be mistreated with God's people. What comforts or pleasures would be hardest for you to give up in order to fully follow Christ?
- -2) What practical safeguards can you put in place to protect yourself from being lured away by the allurements and distractions of this world?
- -3) How does remembering who God truly is help you resist the temporary pleasures and distractions that this world offers?
- -4) How can we intentionally value Christ as the ultimate treasure in our daily lives, especially when circumstances become difficult or stressful?

Take Home/Challenge Questions:

- 1) Spend 30 minutes examining your calendar, bank statements, and screen time from the past month. Ask: "What do these reveal about where my treasure truly is?" Bring your findings to share with an accountability partner or the group next week.
- 2) Identify one specific "allurement" that regularly pulls you away from Christ. Establish one concrete safeguard against it (accountability, time limits, removal of access, etc.). Share your plan with the group for accountability.
