DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

"The Time To Tell"

(2 Kings 7:3-9)

Contribute to the discussion if you feel led to share! Use of Scripture is encouraged!

- 1) The sermon asks 'Why are we sitting here until we die?' - **in what ways might we be passively waiting in our spiritual lives rather than actively engaging with God's mission?**
- 2) James 4:17 states 'to him who knows to do good and does it not, to him it is sin'. **How does understanding evangelism as obedience rather than an option change your perspective on witnessing?**
- 3) The sermon mentioned that the average American has one spiritual conversation per year. **How can we change this pattern in our own lives? What would it look like to have more "natural" conversations about Jesus in everyday life?**
- 4) **How does truly believing that God is preparing the way before us change our approach to living on mission for Him?**

Take Home/Challenge Questions:

- 1) The sermon describes a 'sin of silence' when we have good news but remain quiet. **Who in your life needs to hear about Jesus, and what would it look like to break that silence this week?**
