## A BATTLEFIELD VIEW

To do battle is not a option ... Isaiah 54:17, Romans 8:37, Jeremiah 12:5, John 16:33

Daniel 3: The three Hebrew boys, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego stood up to the King as they refused to bow to the golden idol.

Eph 6: 12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. c) Am I the enemy? 2 Cor 10: <sup>5</sup> Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ. d) A very \_\_\_\_\_ definition: Neh 4 <sup>17</sup> They which builded on the wall, and they that bare burdens, with those that laded, every one with one of his hands wrought in the work, and with the other hand held a weapon. The weapon was not to strike anyone \_\_\_\_\_ the one who touched the wall or got in the way of rebuilding. Not every mocking voice was a threat. 2) Entering the fight, What is your battle cry (Identity flag)?
