<sup>4</sup> Such confidence we have through Christ toward God. <sup>5</sup> Not that we are adequate in ourselves to consider anything as *coming* from ourselves, but our adequacy is from God,

## I. TOGETHER IN CHRIST-CONNECTED CONCERN

<sup>2</sup> You are our letter, written in our hearts, known and read by all men;

## **III. TOGETHER IN SPIRIT-ENABLED COVENANT**

<sup>6</sup> who also made us adequate *as* servants of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.
